Tracy is disabled and is unable to work. She has so far been unsuccessful in receiving disability benefits. She has severe back problems and other health problems, including a degenerative disc disorder, thrush requiring dentures, and an anxiety/panic disorder. Tracy has to live at home with her mother who pays for all their bills with her pension. She feels that she is a burden on her mother. At a recent check-up, Tracy was diagnosed with a heart problem which causes her heart to slow down close to a stop when she is sleeping. She's afraid she'll go to sleep and never wake up.
