 <b>1 person</b>	<b>\$310</b> monthly income limit <hr/> <b>\$3,720</b> annual income limit	<p>The coverage gap means that a person does not qualify for Medicaid and does not earn enough income to receive financial assistance on the health insurance marketplace.</p> <p>People who fall in the coverage gap include working parents, low-wage workers, and some veterans.</p> <p><b>Who can fix the coverage gap?</b></p> <p>Our elected officials have the power to solve this problem. Governor Kemp and the state legislature have so far rejected the money that is set aside to provide health coverage for Georgians in the gap. But they can still bring Georgia's tax dollars back to our state and close the coverage gap, so that people like you can have coverage.</p> <p><b>If you are a person who falls in the coverage gap:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Share your story with Georgians for a Healthy Future.
